

These changes to SMCC By-Laws were approved by BOT Meeting on Aug. 16th, 2018, it needs to be approved by BOD before presenting to AGM. If it is not approved by BOD this item will be removed from AGM Agenda.

Please note that suggested changes are in RED.

Current by-Law for Directors and Officers

3.05 Election, Number and Term

21 directors shall be elected at the first meeting of members and at each succeeding annual meeting at which an election of directors is required. The directors shall hold office for a period of 1 year. Incumbent directors, if qualified, shall be eligible for re-election. If an election of directors is not held at the proper time, the incumbent directors shall continue in office until their successors are elected.

Proposed by-law: NEW 3.05A

3.05A Election, composition of 21 Directors

One third of the 21 directors position will be reserved for young adults who meet all of the following conditions:

- a) Person must be between 21 years to 30 years of age and have worked as a volunteer for SMCC for one year or 100 hours**
- b) Young Adult candidate must have donated minimum \$100 to SMCC and will stay in good standing by donating
\$100 every year till age 25 years
\$250 every year till age 26 to 30 years**
- c) At least one member of candidate's family is a donor member in good standing with voting rights for previous five years**

Current by-Law for Right to Vote

7.07 Right to Vote

7.07 Right to Vote Only donor members registered as such on the date of the notice of the meeting and have donated \$251.00, during the period June 1-May 31 of the preceding year and who shall have been members of the SMCC for at least one year immediately preceding the matter on which the vote is to be taken, shall have the right to vote at any meeting of the members of the SMCC or run for the BOD or trustee member for that given year. (amended September 13, 2015)

Proposed by-law: NEW 7.07A

7.07A Right to Vote – Young Adults

Young adults between age 21 to 30 years will have right to vote if they meet conditions specified in by-law 3.5A

New Definitions in 1.01

“Young adult member” is a person of age between 21 years and 30 years and meets all the requirements stated in By-Law # 3.05A
